Dear Mrs. Moore:

We acknowledge receipt of the 2019-20 Individual Class Size Waiver Requests received from Wake County Schools for **Alston Ridge Elementary**.

G.S. 115C-301(g) prohibits the State Board of Education from granting waivers for Kindergarten through third-grade individual class size overages except under the following circumstances:

- a) Emergencies, or acts of God that impact the availability of classroom space or facilities;
- b) An unanticipated increase in student population of an individual school in excess of two percent (2%) of the average daily membership of that school;
- c) Organizational problems in geographically isolated local school administrative units in which the average daily membership is less than one and one-half per square mile;
- d) Classes organized for a solitary curricular area; or
- e) A charter school closure.

Wake County Schools requested waivers for the following schools based on classes organized for a solitary curricular area as stated above. The request for class size waivers meet the criteria as set out by law and are **approved**. These waivers apply only to the 2019-20 school year.

Alston Ridge Elementary has 1 third-grade class with 24 students (over by 2).
